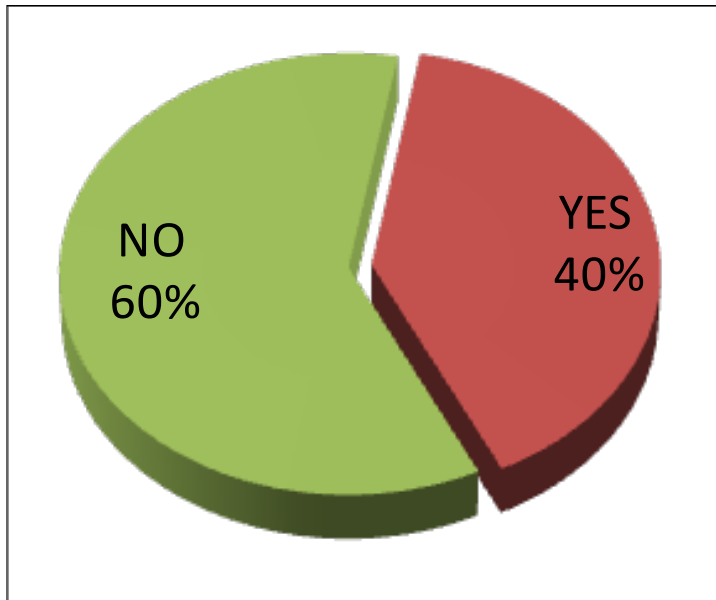


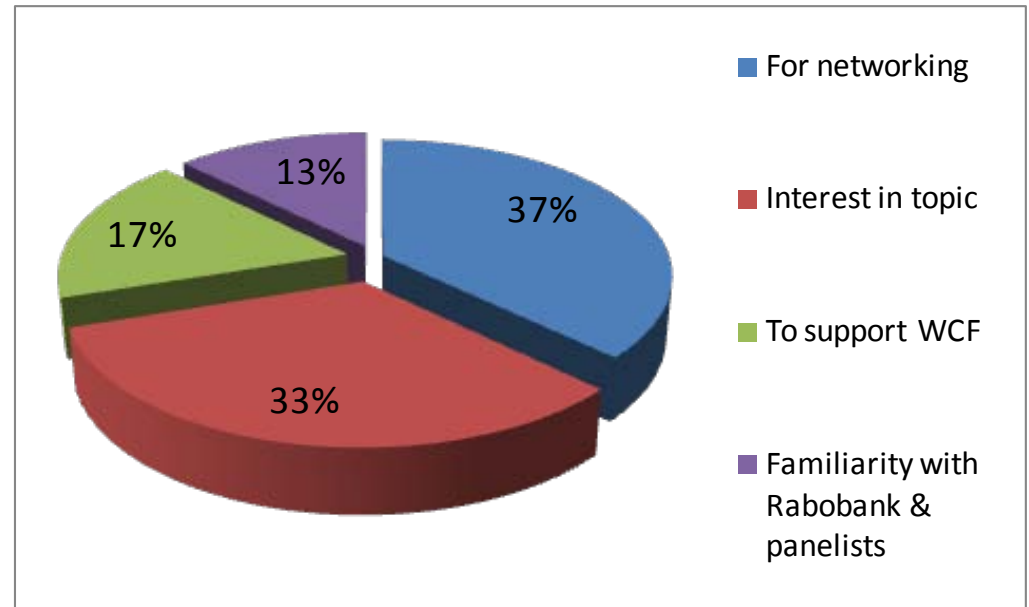

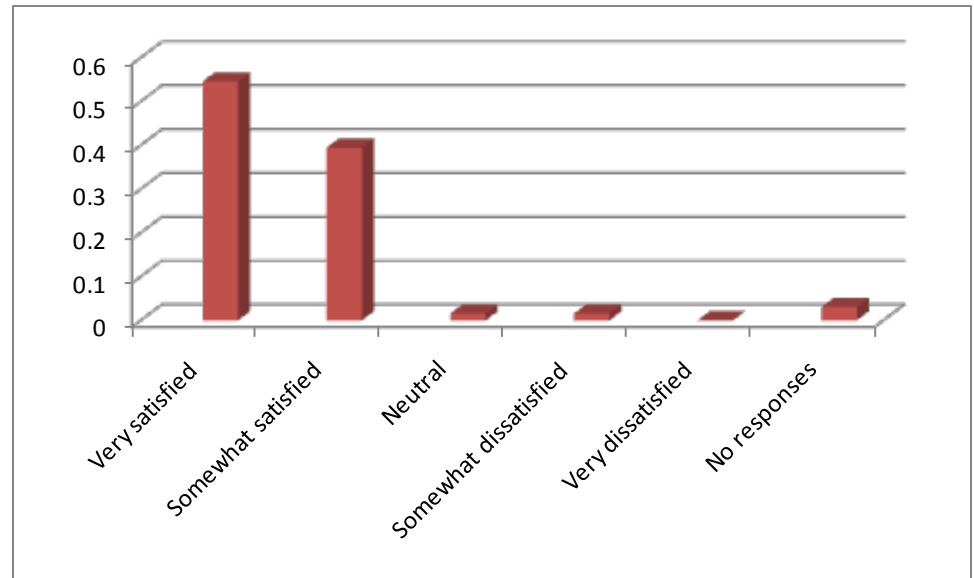
*“Topics must be treated by true specialists, panel discussions must also include specialist so that the general audience can learn the real complexities and trade offs involved in any course of action to improve. ”*
