Jennifer Golden serves as the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Director at the World Cocoa Foundation. She oversees M&E strategy and communications, and leads a team responsible for working with partners to implement M&E on WCF programs.

Before joining WCF, Jennifer worked for nearly 20 years across the private and social sectors in roles related to strategy, operations, project management, and measurement. She spent nearly a decade at TechnoServe, an international development NGO, where she developed and led their Corporate Measurement Framework and System which enabled TechnoServe to measure their results in a standard way across diverse programs in order to support their strategy, learning and decision making. Prior to that role, she structured and led the Volunteer Consultant Program which staffed more than 150 business professionals annually in roles in Africa, Latin America and India. She also worked on measurement at Teach For America and was the Director of Project Management at KaBOOM!, a non-profit organization dedicated to creating playspaces through the participation of communities. Prior to these social sector roles, Jennifer was a Manager at Deloitte Consulting, where she worked for six years leading and conducting engagements focused on strategy and business operations for high-technology, telecommunications, and financial services clients, located primarily in Europe and the US.
